	The accompanying answers to the Tribunal's questionnaire, written by me or given orally, are a true and factual account, to the best of my knowledge.
	I understand that I have a right to an advocate and assistance in the processing of my case from Tribunal officials, to the extent lawfully allowed.
	I have no objection to the Tribunal's requirement that the Respondent have an opportunity to review all submitted evidence, including written statements, transcripts, civil documents, and any other material that my witnesses and I submit. I understand that providing my former civil spouse's current address and contact information is my responsibility and a prerequisite to beginning the process.
	I acknowledge that ministers of the Metropolitan Tribunal are mandated by state law and Archdiocesan policy to report suspected abuse or neglect of a minor to law enforcement and/or child protective services. This includes allegations of current abuse and disclosures of abuse that has happened in the last 3 years.
	I acknowledge that completion of initial paperwork or the submission of my <i>libellus</i> (petition) does not guarantee that the nullity of marriage can or will be declared (i.e., there is no guarantee of an affirmative decision). I further understand that the processing of my case does not start until I submit all necessary documents.
	I understand that my case may take a year or more to complete and no specific date for completion of this process can be given. I agree not to make future marriage arrangements in the Catholic Church until a final decision is made and only if a Declaration of Freedom to Marry has been provided to me. If I do make such arrangements, I do so at my own risk and agree to hold no one else accountable for such action.
	It is my responsibility to provide witnesses (names and addresses) and any other proofs necessary to support the ground(s) of my case.
	I understand that a psychological, psychiatric, or cultural expert may be called upon to either review the case file or to conduct face-to-face interviews of either party and to prepare a report based upon the documents in the case file and the interview. I further understand that the report submitted to the Tribunal is for the sole purpose of this ecclesiastical matter and remains the property of the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis. A copy of this report will not be given to the parties in the case or released to any other outside party.
	I understand that this process concerns only ecclesiastical (church) matters and has no binding force or effect in civil law and other civil matters within the United States of America. I also understand and agree not to use information learned or obtained in this process against anyone in any other forum, ecclesiastical or civil. Furthermore, I agree that no civil lawsuit will ever be brought by me against the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis, any appeal tribunals, its officials, witnesses, or any other agents legitimately involved in my case and I hold all of said parties harmless from
	any and all claims arising from the process of this case. I understand that both parties will receive a copy of the definitive decision and I acknowledge that the outcome of this process may not result in a declaration of nullity of my marriage. I further understand that if a negative decision is rendered, I will not receive a Declaration of Freedom to Marry and I remain canonically bound to the marriage under consideration, and that I will not be free to marry in the Catholic Church.
	Although nullity of the marriage may be declared, I understand that the judge(s) in this case may delay permission for me to marry in the Catholic Church if the case facts indicate that further pastoral or professional counseling is required to help me in any future marriage.
