Advocates are admitted to minister at the Tribunal on a case by case basis when the Petitioner or Respondent presents a signed mandate to the Court. Advocates not appearing on this list, may also be admitted to the Tribunal, at the discretion of the Judicial Vicar, when the Tribunal is presented with a mandate. The Judicial Vicar may require letters of recommendation and suitability before an advocate not appearing on this list is admitted.
